

## These guidelines are designed to keep children safe when using digital technologies when in school. However, they also provide a recommended framework for safe ICT use at home.

- I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- ★ I will only use my class e-mail address or my own school e-mail address when e-mailing.
- ★ I will only open e-mail attachments from people I know, or who my teacher has approved.
- I will not tell other people my ICT passwords.
- I will only open/delete my own files.
- ★ I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or nasty. If I accidentally find anything like this I will tell my teacher immediately.
- **I** will not give out my own details such as my name, phone number or home address.
- I will not arrange to meet someone unless this is part of a school project approved by my teacher and a responsible adult comes with me.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community.
- I know that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/carer will be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my E-Safety.
