London is the capital city of England. (EYFS)

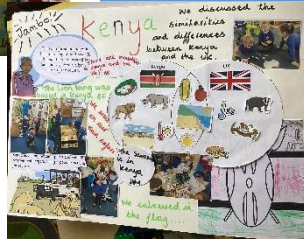


On Tuesdays we 'travel' to countries all around the world. We look at the similarities and differences in comparison to Sedbergh. (EYFS)
