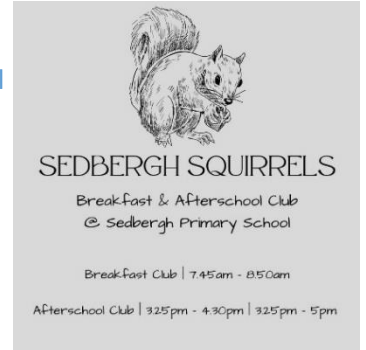


WRAP AROUND CARE FOR SEPTEMBER
