We have started as we mean to go on this week with the pupils settling straight back into their learning and embarking on some new, exciting topics.

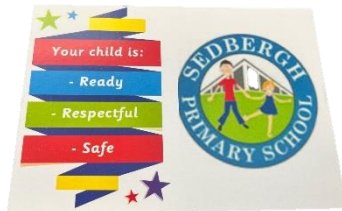
Behaviour in school:
