Waterworks assembly:

In assembly on Monday, we were visited by a representative from United Utilities who taught the children about where water comes from and how to conserve it. Y6 then completed a workshop and learnt about the water cycle, how water gets into your taps, water conservation and 'fatbergs' that collect in water pipes. They conducted an experiment about what not to flush down the toilet and also took home a 4 minute shower timer to try and keep the time spent showering to a minimum!
