KS2 Bingo:

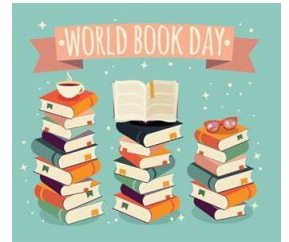
